



Green Fleets of the Bluegrass Program Overview



Green Fleets of the Bluegrass aims to improve the environmental performance of vehicle fleets across Kentucky by reducing petroleum fuel use.

The program is structured to provide flexibility for diverse fleets across the Commonwealth to pursue best practices while achieving recognition for successes along the way. Participating fleet managers complete an online survey once per year to submit quantitative data and descriptions of fleet activities.

Green Fleets of the Bluegrass is a voluntary program of the Kentucky Clean Fuels Coalition (KCFC).

Criteria and Ratings

Participating fleets are evaluated on an annual basis on seven criteria:

Vehicles, Fuel, Maintenance, Operation, Partnerships, Strategy, & Transparency.

Fleets are recognized with an annual Green Fleets of the Bluegrass rating on a three-tier scale:



Improving



Achieving



Leading

Eligibility

Any centralized fleet operating in Kentucky with at least *ten* vehicles is eligible for participation in Green Fleets of the Bluegrass. All ground vehicles are eligible for participation including passenger cars, light duty, medium duty, and heavy duty trucks, freight, forklifts, and tractors.

Fleets from entities across all sectors are encouraged to participate including companies, manufacturers, municipalities, educational institutions, nonprofits, and others.

Cost

There is no fee for participating in Green Fleets of the Bluegrass. KCFC membership is not required for participation. KCFC members receive administrative assistance for Green Fleets of the Bluegrass program implementation.

Data Collection

Participation Deadline

Green Fleets of the Bluegrass participants must submit entries annually by November 1st to be eligible for ratings and award presentations in December.
